Disciplinary Rules

1. It shall be a disciplinary offence for a player in the course of or in connection with a match to misconduct himself or to act at any time in a manner calculated to prejudice the good name or interests of the Club
2. For the purpose of these rules the expression "the player" shall throughout these rules be deemed to mean and include not only any player but also any member of officials of any club or if appropriate any other person involved in any of possible misconduct occurring on the field of play, or on the premises of the club; as may be appropriate in the particular circumstances.
3. Before any penalty is imposed there shall be a disciplinary hearing before the Executive Committee. At least seven days notice in writing of the hearing and of the offence alleged shall be given to the player in writing. The player shall be entitled to attend the hearing.
4. If at the hearing the Executive Committee find the offence proved, it shall have the power to impose one of the following penalties:
 - Reprimand
 - A fine of not more than £50
 - Suspension for one or more matches
 - Expulsion from the ClubSave that a player may be for, the same offence both suspended and fined.
5. A player found by the Executive Committee to have committed an offence or upon whom the Executive Committee has imposed a penalty shall have the right of appeal to the Trustees. Notice of appeal setting out the grounds must be given in writing to the Secretary of the Club within fourteen days of the decision of the Executive Committee, together with a deposit of £50. Upon giving Notice of Appeal, the penalty shall not take effect pending the hearing of the appeal.
6. The appeal shall be by way of rehearing. The player shall have the same rights of attendance and representation, and to call witnesses as they had before the Executive Committee.
7. The Trustees may confirm, increase, reduce or set aside the decision of the Executive Committee. In the case, where no grievances exist between the player and the club, the Executive Committee decision will stand final on a non-appealing person. The Trustees shall also have the power where they consider the appeal without merit to order the deposit to be forfeited.
8. The decision of the Trustees, or if no appeal, of the Executive Committee, shall be final and binding.
9. In the event of a member being banned from playing cricket at the Club. The member of the Club shall not be entitled to any membership-related payment as a refund, or be allowed to use any of the Club's facilities.



Safety Guidelines:

It is compulsory that all players under 18 wear a helmet, when batting, or standing up to the stumps when keeping wicket against a hard ball in matches and in practice.

Each colt **must** have a helmet, box (protective equipment) and bat. Although the club encourages the colt to have the full cricket equipment.

Terms and conditions

All Colt members must abide to the SKLP Cricket Club rules and code of conduct. A copy of the Clubs Constitution can be obtained from the Club Secretary or Head of Colts Academy.

Commitment to the Club

Once the Colt is a member of the Club, they cannot represent / become a member of another Cricket Club, whilst they are a member of SKLPCC except under exceptional cases; which would require written approval from the SKLPCC committee. If a Colt is found to be member of a number of Clubs without approval, disciplinary action maybe taken which could result in the Colt having his/her membership terminated with SKLPCC.

Personal belongings

The Club will take NO responsibility for personal belongings. It is the Colts duty to look after there own items, such as mobile phones, money, wallets, jewellery etc when they are representing the Club and at the Clubs (both SKLPCC and away) premises.

Indoor & outdoor footwear

Non-marking white trainers must be worn during all indoor practice sessions.

For outdoor practice and matches, Colts must wear proper cricket boots. This is not only a requirement, but also a safety issue for the child. Non-spiked shoe can be very dangerous if the ground outside is wet when practice session or matches are played.

Club Kit

All Colts must wear there Club whites at ALL practice sessions and matches. It is also recommended that the Colt has there own cricket equipment.
